What's on in Liverpool?

Taking a break? Here's a guide to some attractions close to the BT Conference Centre during the week

Tate Liverpool, Albert Docks (www.tate.org.uk/liverpool)

Mondrian and His Studios (until 5 October) – a special exhibition to mark the 70th Anniversary of the death of Dutch painter Piet Mondrian (1872–1944), renowned as one of the most important contributors to the development of abstraction at the beginning of the 20th century.

DLA Piper Series: Constellations – this display, specially selected from the Tate collection, encourages the exploration of connections between major contemporary works of outstanding quality and significance by arranging them in five 'constellations'.

Carlos Cruz-Diez: Dazzle Ship – Venezuelan artist Carlos Cruz-Diez, inspired by the 'dazzle' camouflage of the First World War, uses the historic pilot ship *Edmund Gardner*, moored in the dry dock by Liverpool's Albert Dock, as the canvas for this new work.

Liverpool's cathedrals

Liverpool's Anglican Cathedral, completed in 1978, is the largest in the UK and the fifth largest in the world. St James Mount, Liverpool L1 7AZ, open daily 08:00 – 18:00.

Liverpool Metropolitan Cathedral is the seat of the Archbishop of Liverpool, one of Liverpool's many listed buildings. It is sometimes known locally as 'Paddy's Wigwam' or the 'Mersey Funnel'. Brownlow Hill, L3 5TQ, open daily from 07:30 – 18:00.

Royal Court Heritage Tour

Behind the scenes tour of one of Liverpool's best loved buildings. The Royal Court theatre is a Grade II listed building, a magnificent example of a theatre built in the Art Deco style. Situated on Roe Street, close to Lime Street Station, 1 hour tours of this iconic building can be booked via www.royalcourtLiverpool.co.uk or 00 44 870 787 1866.

Cavern Club: Oasis (Friday 10 October 20:30 – www.cavernclub.org)
